# Transfer of Ownership Information



*On July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 the Government introduced new legislation relating to the Transfer of Ownership for horses, ponies and donkeys.*

*Under S.I. No. 201/2016 , **Equidae (Transfer of Ownership)** , there are a number of requirements that have to be met to avoid severe penalties.*

## **Instructions for Sellers / Vendors of Kerry Bog Pony:**

1. Complete Section 1 of the Kerry Bog Pony Transfer of Ownership form with the animal's details.
2. Complete and sign Section 2 of the form with your name, address, contact details and equine premises number.
3. Have the Buyer/New Owner complete and sign Section 3 with their name, address, contact details and equine premises number.
4. Take a copy of the form for your records (photocopy or photograph will suffice)
5. Give the form to the Buyer/New Owner
6. Give the passport to the Buyer/New owner of the animal at the time of sale

## **Instructions for Buyers/ New owners of Kerry Bog Pony:**

1. Complete Section 3 of the Kerry Bog Pony Transfer of Ownership form.
2. Ensure the Seller/Vendor has completed and signed Section 2 of the Kerry Bog Pony Transfer of Ownership form.
3. Take a copy of the form for your records (photocopy or photograph will suffice).
4. Return this fully completed form and the fee of €15/£12, with the passport to Horse Sport Ireland.
5. Equine Premises Numbers only relate to premises in the Republic of Ireland.

**THIS MUST BE DONE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF TAKING OWNERSHIP OF THE ANIMAL.**

## **Other information**

**Equine Premises Number** - It is a legal requirement under the Control on Places where Horses are kept Regulations (SI 113 of 2014) that all premises where equine are kept must be registered with the Department of Agriculture. Accordingly, you should ensure that your equine is being kept on a registered premises. If your holding is not already registered as an Equine Premises, you should apply immediately to DAFM for an Equine Premises Number.

**Failure to register the Transfer of Ownership within the time limit is a serious offence, liable to high penalties. DAFM authorized officers will carry out inspections and will have the authority to inspect records and documents. Giving, false, misleading or incomplete information is also a legal offence.**
